Once there lived a proud lion in a jungle. He often killed the animals. The animals of the jungle were afraid of him.

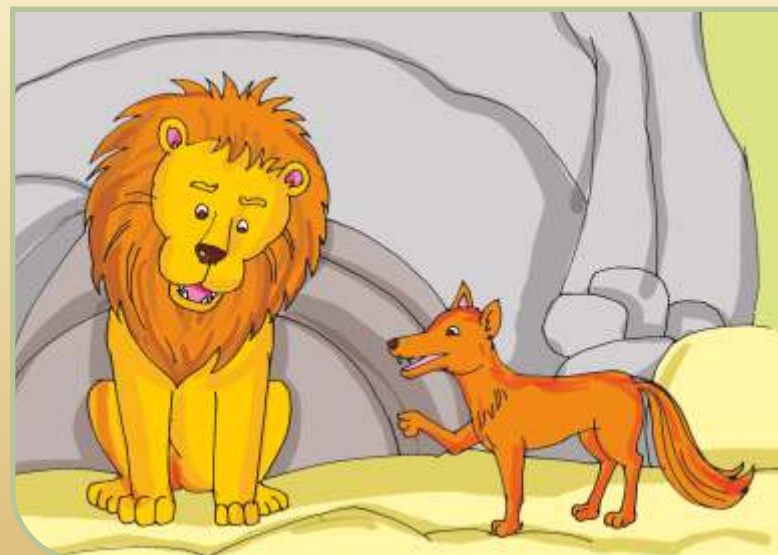


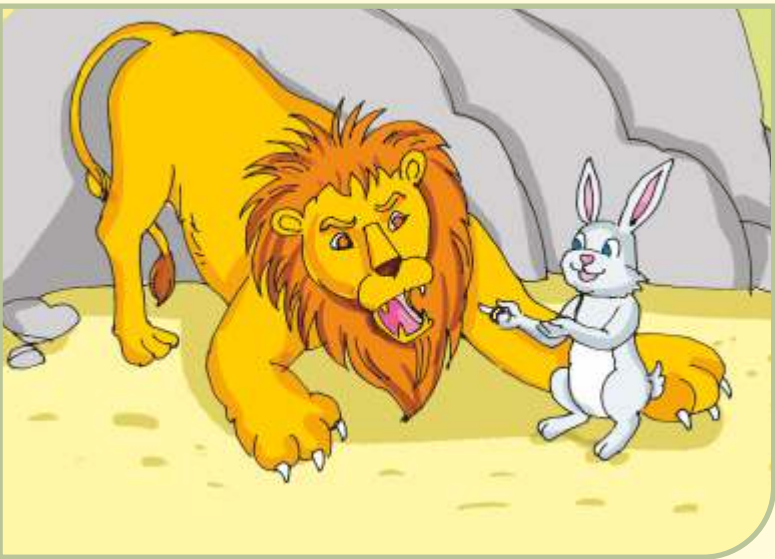
The animals called a meeting. They decided to get rid of this proud lion. The lion was very big and strong. The rabbit thought of a plan.

The rabbit broke the news of the lion's death to all the animals.

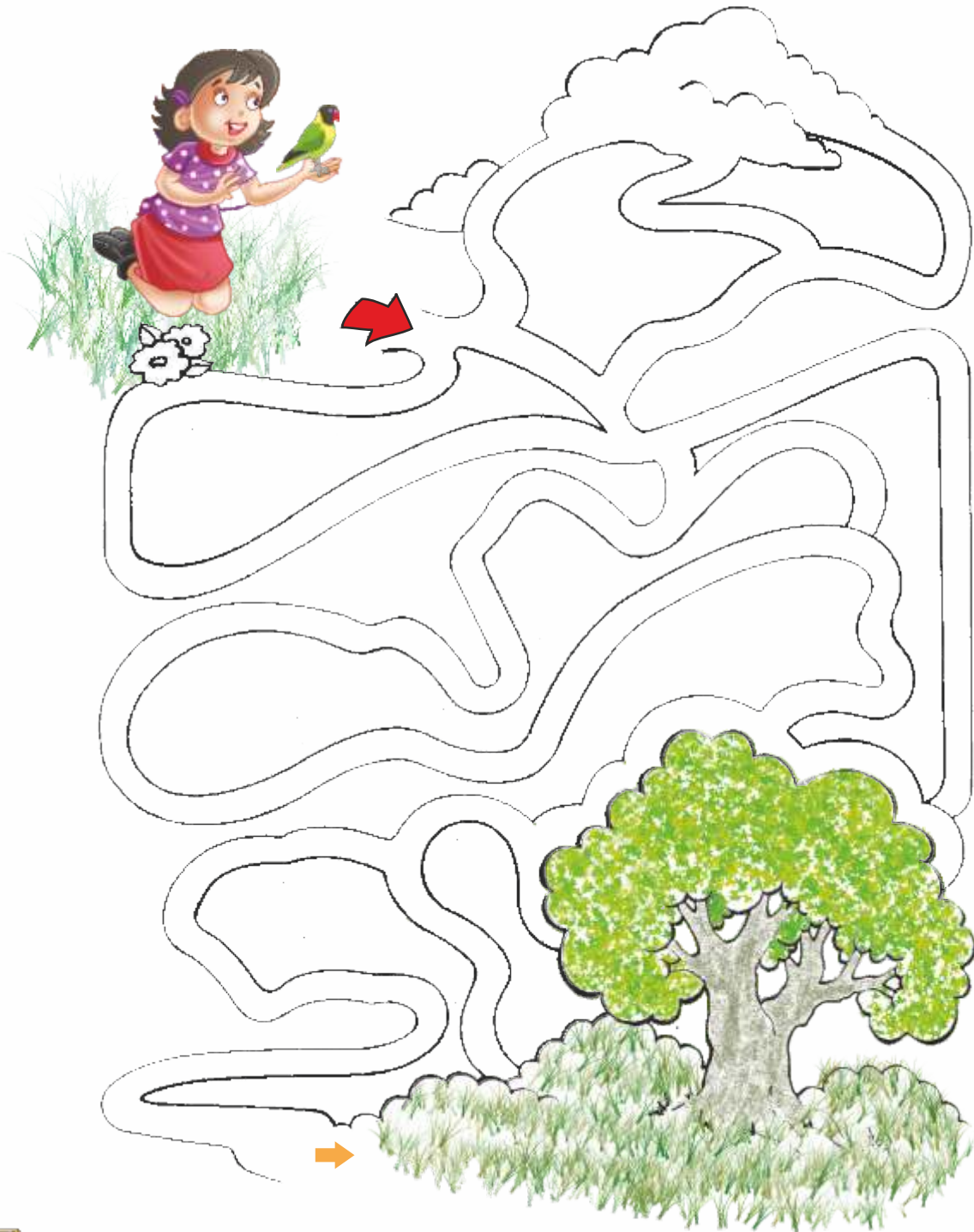
