






THE CLEVER RABBIT AND THE LION

The animals called a meeting. They decided to get rid of this proud lion. The lion was very big and strong. The rabbit thought of a plan.


Next day, the fox went to the lion and told him. You are mighty and our lord. But the rabbit says that there wandered another lion more powerful than you.






