
GREETING CARD






MIRROR PAINTING


- 1. Take a sheet (material provided) and fold it into half.

- 4. Now, open it to see the mirror prints on the other side.





ORIGAMI - RABBIT

- 4. Fold along the dotted line.








5. Turn the paper.

8. Make its eyes and nose, and the rabbit face is ready.















Trace over the dotted lines and colour it as shown below in the picture.




PAPER FAN


Follow the given steps to make a paper fan.
